NOTICE FOR TENTATIVE RECRUITMENT RULES  
OF DRUG INSPECTOR UNDER HEALTH DEPARTMENT  
Imphal, the 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2020.

Whereas, as per existing RR for Drug Inspector (DI); educational qualifications required for direct recruitment of DI include inter alia (1) Pharmaceutical Chemists Diploma by the Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain and (2) Fellow of Royal Institute of Chemistry of Great Britain (Branch E). However, as per Rule 49 of the Drugs and Cosmetics Rules, 1945, these educational qualifications are redundant now. "Rule 49: Qualifications of Inspectors" states that a person who is appointed an Inspector under the Act shall be a person who has a degree in Pharmacy or Pharmaceutical Sciences or Medicine with specialisation in Clinical Pharmacology or Microbiology from a University established in India by law.

2. Whereas, all the posts of Drug Inspector (AYUSH) under the Directorate of AYUSH are to be filled up by promotion from Pharmacist(AYUSH) with 8(eight) years regular service in the grade as per RR. The existing RR for DI under Health Department prescribes for filling up all the posts by direct recruitment only.

3. Hence, as an exercise to amend the existing 37(thirty-seven) years old RR of DI post, a **tentative RR of Drug Inspector post under Health Department is hereby notified as Annexure-A.**

4. Suggestions, comments, etc. to the said tentative RR are invited from all the stakeholders within 30(thirty) days from the date of notification in the official website [www.manipurhealthdirectorate.in](http://www.manipurhealthdirectorate.in)
