*Common Entrance Examination (CEE) for B.Sc. Nursing, Pharmacy & Allied and Healthcare courses	07-06-2026 (10 AM to 12 Noon).
Entrance Examination for ANM course.	07-06-2026 (2 PM to 4 PM).
Entrance Examination for M.Sc. Nursing Course.	07-06-2026 (2 PM to 4 PM).

\*CEE for B.Sc. Nursing course is for admission to both Government & Private Institutes of Manipur.

2. Eligibility criteria for the courses are as follows:

B.Sc. Nursing	(i) Class 10+2 (Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute with minimum aggregate of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) and passed in all subjects including English (40% marks for SC/ST/OBC candidates). For RIPANS, Aizawl, 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed with minimum aggregate of 50% marks in PCB & English (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC/PwD candidates). (ii) Age shall be 17-35 years as on 31-12-2026. Upper age limit to be relaxed by 5 years for PwD candidates.
Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science (BMLS)	(i) Candidate must have passed Senior Secondary (10+2) or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry & Biology (Botany + Zoology) subjects (ii) Age shall be minimum 17 years on or before 31-12-2026.
Bachelor of Medical Radiology and Imaging Technology (B. MRIT)	(i) Candidate must have passed Senior Secondary (10+2) or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry & Biology (Botany + Zoology) subjects (ii) Age shall be minimum 17 years on or before 31-12-2026.
Bachelor of Optometry (B. Optom.)	(i) Candidate must have passed Senior Secondary (10+2) or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry & Biology/Mathematics with 50% aggregate (40% marks for SC/ST/OBC candidates). and pass in English (ii) Age shall be minimum 17 years on or before 31-12-2026.



Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT)	(i) Candidate must have passed Senior Secondary (10+2) or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry & Biology (or Botany & Zoology) with 50% aggregate (40% for SC/ST/OBC/PwD candidates) with English pass (ii) Age shall be minimum 17 years on or before 31-12-2026.
Bachelor of Pharmacy	(i) For RIPANS, Aizawl: 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute with minimum aggregate of 50% marks in PCB or Physics, Chemistry & Maths (PCM) and English (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC/PwD candidates) or, passed Diploma in Pharmacy from a recognised Institute with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC/PwD candidates). (ii) For other Institutes: 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute in PCB or PCM with English as one of the subjects. (iii) Age shall be minimum 17 years as on 31-12-2026.
Diploma in Pharmacy	(i) 10+2 (Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute in PCB or PCM. (ii) Age shall be minimum 17 years as on 31-12-2026.
ANM	(i) 10+2 (any stream) Exam passed from a recognized Institute. (ii) Only Female candidates may apply. (iii) Age shall be 17 – 35 years as on 31-12-2026.
M.Sc. Nursing	(i) B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing degree from a recognised Institute with a minimum aggregate of 55% marks for Gen/OBC and 50% for ST/SC candidates. (ii) Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife with any State Nursing Council (iii) Age: 21 – 35 years (for Open category) & maximum of 50 years (for sponsored category) as on 31-12-2026. (iv) Minimum one year of work experience in a recognised Institute after Basic B.Sc. Nursing or, before/after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing. (v) Sponsoring authority shall be the Government of Manipur or any undertaking under the State Government. (vi) Candidates applying for Sponsored category, shall mandatorily bring NOC and Sponsorship certificates on the day of counselling sessions to be eligible for State Government nomination

3. 'Online Application Form' is available in the dedicated online portal <https://manipurmc.mn.gov.in/> from **12<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2026**. Link to the online portal is also available in the official website [www.manipurhealthdirectorat.mn.gov.in](http://www.manipurhealthdirectorat.mn.gov.in). 'Online Application Form' must be filled after reading 'Instructions for filling Online Application Form'.

4. Admit cards can be downloaded from the online portal from 30-05-2026 to 05-06-2026.

5. Application fees (non-refundable) for the courses are as follows:



- i). For B.Sc. Nursing courses: Rs. 1500/- (Rs. 1000 for SC / ST) for each course.
  - ii). For Pharmacy & Allied and Healthcare Courses: Rs.1500/- (Rs. 1000 for SC / ST) for each course.
  - iii). For M.Sc. Nursing course: Rs. 2900/- (Rs 2500 for SC / ST).
  - iv). For ANM course: Rs. 300/- (Rs. 200/- for SC / ST).
6. All the three entrance examinations will be conducted in the following Examination Cities:  
(i) IMPHAL, (ii) SENAPATI & (iii) CHURACHANDPUR.

**General Instructions to Candidates for the Entrance Examinations for Nursing,  
Pharmacy & Allied and Healthcare Courses for the academic session 2026-27**

1. The candidate, before submitting the application form online, must ensure his/her eligibility to appear in the respective Examinations.
2. Candidates must be extremely careful in filling in the Application form. Any information can be modified/edited before submitting each Section. Once the final submission of the form is done, information can no longer be modified/edited.
3. Candidates must read the instructions about photographs, signature, and all certificates carefully before uploading.
4. Candidates must ensure that mobile numbers and e-mail ID filled in the online Application Form are their own or Parents/Guardian only as this Directorate will communicate through SMS or e-mail on the given mobile number and e-mail ID.
5. Applications once submitted cannot be withdrawn. Candidates must note that mere deduction of fee from the bank account is not proof of fee payment. The payment should be supported by fee payment and generation of the Confirmation Page.
6. The examination fee once deposited will not be refunded. The fee will not be carried forward to a future examination.
7. The Application Form other than the one filled in online mode will not be accepted. Candidates are not required to send the Confirmation Page of the Online Application Form or any other document to the DME. However, the candidates are advised to preserve at least one copy of the Confirmation Page along with the proof of fee paid for future reference.
8. Candidates must ensure that all the certificates to be enclosed are correct and valid. It is to be noted that validity period for OBC certificates is 1(one) year from date of issue. Incorrect or invalid enclosures will be summarily rejected.
9. Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected and such candidates may be prosecuted under any court of law and his/her candidature may be cancelled.
10. This Directorate reserves the right to withdraw permission, granted inadvertently if any, to a candidate who is not eligible to appear in the Entrance Examinations for Nursing, Pharmacy & Allied and Healthcare Courses for the academic session 2026-27



11. In case of any ambiguity in the interpretation of any of the norms /terms/rules/instructions regarding registration of candidates, allocation of Exam Centre, issuance of Admit Card, the conduct of exam and publication of Result, the interpretation /determination of the Selection Board shall be final and binding.
12. Incomplete applications and applications not in accordance with instructions are liable to be rejected without any further intimation.

D. Pharm passed candidates applying for B. Pharm course shall also follow the same scheme of examination as above. **There shall be no separate question paper for D. Pharm passed candidates.**
