**I. STAFF NURSE**

The examination for the recruitment for the post of Staff Nurses at Churachandpur Medical College and DH Churachandpur will consists of the following parts:

**A. Written Examination:**

The written examination will consist of 120 (one hundred and twenty) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs), each carrying 01 (one) mark, to be answered in 03 (three) hours duration. There will be NO negative marks for incorrect answers.

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## B. Oral assessment of Technical Domain Expertise & Aptitude

Only the candidates qualified in the Written Examination shall be called for Oral Assessment of Technical Domain Expertise & Aptitude carrying 80 (eighty) marks.

The final merit list shall be drawn on the basis of total marks obtained in Written Examination and Oral Assessment of Technical Domain expertise & Aptitude.

## II. DRIVER

The examination for the Direct recruitment to the post of Driver at Churachandpur Medical College and DH Churachandpur will compose only of written examination consisting of 100 (one hundred) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) each carrying 01(one) mark for a correct answer with a total of 100 marks for a duration of 3 (three) hours. There will be NO negative marks for incorrect answers.

Weightage of Questions, Syllabus & Marks of Written Examination will be given as follows:

## III. GRADE IV

The examination for the Direct recruitment to the Grade IV posts at Churachandpur Medical College and DH Churachandpur (Sweeper, Ward, Attendant, Cook, Chowkidar, Dhobi, Daftary, Aya, Peon, Jamadar, Jugali, Electrical, Plumber, Dissection Hall, Attendant, etc.) will compose only of written examination consisting of 100 (one hundred) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) each carrying 01(one) mark for a correct answer with a total of 100 with a duration of 3 (three) hours. There will be NO negative marks for incorrect answers.
