No. DHS-304(1)/1/2024-DHS-DHS: Entrance Examinations for the following courses for 2024 session will be held on the following dates & time :

Common Entrance Examination for B.Sc.Nursing & Paramedical courses.	08-06-2024; (10 AM to 12 NOON).
Entrance Examination for ANM / GNM course.	08-06-2024; (2 PM to 4 PM).
Entrance Examination for M.Sc.Nursing course.	08-06-2024; (2 PM to 4 PM).

Common Entrance Examination (CEE) for B.Sc.Nursing courses is for admission to both Government & private institutes of Manipur. CEE for Paramedical courses is for admission to State nominee seats outside the State.

2. General instructions to the candidates are given in Annexure-A.

3. Eligibility criteria for the courses are as follows.

Sl. No.	Name of courses	Eligibility criteria
1	B.Sc. Nursing***	(i) Class 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute with minimum aggregate of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB); and passed in all subjects including English. For RIPANS, Aizawl, 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed with minimum aggregate of 50% marks in PCB & English (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC candidates). (ii) Age shall be 17-35 years as on 31-12-2024.
2	B.Sc. in Radio Imaging Technology; B.Sc. in Optometry & Ophthalmic Techniques; B.Sc. in Medical Lab. Technology.	(i) Class 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute with minimum aggregate of 50% marks in PCB & English (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC candidates); and must have passed in all subjects. (ii) Age shall be minimum 17 years as on 31-12-2024.
3	Bachelor of Pharmacy.	(i) For RIPANS, Aizawl: 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute with minimum aggregate of 50% marks in PCB or Physics, Chemistry & Maths (PCM) and English (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC candidates); or, passed Diploma in Pharmacy from a recognised Institute with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks. (ii) For other Institutes: 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute in PCB or PCM with English as one of the subjects. (iii) Age shall be minimum 17 years as on 31-12-2024.

4	Diploma in Pharmacy.	(i) 10+2(Sc.) Exam passed from a recognised Institute in PCB or PCM with English as one of the subjects. (ii) Age shall be minimum 17 years as on 31-12-2024.
5	ANM & GNM.	i) 10+2(any stream) Exam passed from a recognized Institute. ii) Only Female candidates may apply. iii) Age shall be 17-35 years as on 31-12-2024.
6	M.Sc. Nursing	i) B. Sc. Nursing degree from a recognised institute with minimum aggregate of 55 % marks for Gen/OBC and 50% for ST/SC candidates. ii) Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife under MNC. iii) Age: 21–35 years (for Open category) & maximum of 50 years (for sponsored category) as on 31-12-2024. iv) Minimum one year of work experience in a recognised Institute after Basic B. Sc. Nursing or, before/after Post Basic B. Sc. Nursing. v) Sponsoring authority shall be the Government of Manipur or any undertaking under the State Government.

4. **Online Application Form is available in the dedicated online portal <https://manipurserviceplus.in> from 15-May-2024 to 27-May-2024.** A link to the online portal is also available in this Directorate website www.manipurhealthdirectorat.mn.gov.in. Online Application Forms must be filled up after carefully reading the "Instructions for filling up Application Form" given in Annexure-B.

5. **Admit cards will be available in the online portal <https://manipurserviceplus.in> from 30-May-2024** and can be downloaded after login.

6. Application fees (non-refundable) for the courses:

- i). For B.Sc.Nursing & Paramedical courses: ₹1500/- (₹ 1000 for SC/ST) for each course.
- ii). For ANM & GNM courses: ₹ 300/- (₹ 200/- for SC / ST).
- iii). For M.Sc. Nursing course: ₹ 2900/- (₹ 2500 for SC / ST).

7. All the three entrance examinations will be conducted in the following Examination Cities :
(i) IMPHAL & (ii) GUWAHATI.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES FOR THE COMMON ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR NURSING AND PARAMEDICAL COURSES 2024

1. No correction facility will be given at any stage after the Registration.
2. Be extremely careful in filling in the Application Form. You can edit/modify any information before submitting each Section. Check again before pressing the 'SUBMIT' button.
3. Read instructions carefully about photographs, signature, and all certificates (if any) before uploading. Mobile Number and 'Email ID' need to be verified through OTP.
4. Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected and such candidates may be prosecuted under any court of law and his/her candidature may be cancelled.
5. Incomplete applications and applications not in accordance with instructions are liable to be rejected without any further intimation.
6. The examination fees are non-refundable.
7. Candidates are advised to regularly check the website <https://manipurhealthdirectorat.mn.gov.in> for any further updates or information.
8. Directorate of Health Services, Manipur (DHS) reserves the right to withdraw permission granted inadvertently, if any, to a candidate who is not eligible to appear in the Common Entrance Examinations 2024.
9. In case of any ambiguity in the interpretation of any of the norms /terms/rules/instructions regarding registration of candidates, allocation of Exam Centre, issuance of Admit Card, the conduct of exam and publication of Result, decision of the DHS shall be final.
10. The candidate, before submitting the application form online, must ensure his/her eligibility to appear in the test.
11. Candidates must ensure that mobile numbers and e-mail ID filled in the online Application Form are their own or Parents/Guardian only as **DHS will communicate through SMS or e-mail on the registered mobile number or e-mail ID. There will be no further notifications in the local media regarding examination /counselling.**
12. The Application Form other than the one filled in online mode will not be accepted. The candidates are not required to send the Confirmation Page of the Online Application Form or any other document to the DHS. However, the candidates are advised to preserve at least one copy of the Confirmation Page along with the proof of fee paid for future reference.
13. Please check your photograph and signature before submission of the Application Form. In case the photograph or signature is blurred or not visible to identify the identity of the candidate then, the application will be rejected and no option for correction or revision will be permitted.

STEPS FOR REGISTRATION IN THE ONLINE PORTAL:

1. Go to <https://manipurserviceplus.in>
2. Enter the registration page in the online portal by clicking on the **REGISTER** in the upper right-hand corner of the home page.
3. **Filling up the Registration form:** Enter Full Name of Candidate (as in the Class-X Pass Certificate), valid Email ID, Mobile number & domicile State. All SMS Notifications for the entrance examination will be sent to this registered mobile number.
4. **Choice of Password:** Password should be at least '9' characters with at least one special character [!@#\$%^&*], one numeric, one small case and one upper case letter. E.g. Rahim#123.
5. After filling up the Registration Form, click on the **SUBMIT**.
6. **Verify Email ID and Mobile number** by entering the OTPs received separately in the registered email and mobile number provided in Step-3 above.
7. After successful verification of email and mobile number, registration in the online portal <https://manipurserviceplus.in> is completed.
