Imphal, the 5th September, 2026

No. DME-18/1/2026-HEALTH: Candidates registered for Manipur Medical e-Counselling 2026-27 shall compulsorily fill in their Seat Choices in the web-based application at <https://manipurmc.mn.gov.in> to participate in the Second Round of the e-Counselling for allotment of (a) State Government Quota seats for MBBS/BDS/BASLP courses at RIMS, JNIMS, SAHS, CMC and RDC Guwahati, (b) Management Quota seats for MBBS course at SAHS and (c) NRI Quota seats for MBBS course at SAHS, as per the following tentative timelines:

2. NEET-UG 2026 qualified candidates who have not registered in the previous round(s) are allowed to register and fill in their Seat Choices in the web-based application <https://manipurmc.mn.gov.in> to participate in the Second Round of the Manipur Medical e-Counselling 2026-27 as per schedules given above. Link to the web-based application is also available on the website <https://manipurhealthdirectorat.mn.gov.in>. Before registering in the web application, candidates shall carefully read the “**Technical Instructions for Registration**” notified vide this Directorate notification of even No. dated 12-08-2026.

3. Registration will be complete only after payment of the following 02 (two) kinds of Fees:

a. Non-refundable Application Fees as follows:

- (i) ₹2000/- (₹1500/- for ST and SC candidates) for State Government seats.
- (ii) ₹2000/- for Private (Management and NRI quota) seats at SAHS.
- (iii) ₹4000/- (₹3500/- for ST and SC candidates) for both Government and Private (Management / NRI quota) Seats.

b. Refundable Security Fees of 15000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) for all categories. This amount shall be refunded after completion of all rounds of counselling subject to fulfilment of relevant conditions.

No fees shall be separately charged for Choice Filling in the web application.



4. General instructions for registration and SOP for the Second Round of the e-Counselling 2026-27 are hereby enclosed as Annexure 'A' and 'B' for kind reference.
5. Merit list of candidates for the Second Round of the e-Counselling 2026-27 shall be prepared from the candidates who have successfully filled in their Seat Choices for the said Round. Choice of seat filled in any round will not be valid for further rounds.
6. Candidates who have exercised the "**Float**" option in the First Round and are willing to upgrade, as well as candidates whose seat allotted in the First Round has been **rejected** or **surrendered**, shall be eligible for upgradation to a higher-preference seat in the Second Round, subject to their merit, choice preference and availability of seats. In case a candidate is allotted a new seat in the Second Round, the seat previously allotted to the candidate in the First Round shall be deemed to have been vacated and shall be made available for allotment to another eligible candidate in the Second Round itself.
7. The available seats in the Second Round of e-Counselling shall be notified later.
8. Security deposit will be forfeited if a candidate fails to join the institute after allotment of Seat in the 2nd Round.

ANNEXURE A: GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

FRESH REGISTRATION (FOR CANDIDATES APPLYING FOR THE FIRST TIME)

1. Qualified and eligible candidates are required to register in the web-based application <https://manipurmc.mn.gov.in>, to participate in the counselling process for allotment of seat. Directorate of Medical Education (DME) does not allot any seats manually.
2. Registration through any other mode is not allowed.
3. A candidate can submit NEET-UG Counselling application/registration form for State Counselling only once. Any candidate found to have submitted more than one application/registration form for NEET-UG Counselling shall be debarred from NEET-UG Counselling allotment process and his/her candidature shall be cancelled.
4. A candidate can choose from 3 (three) Seat types, namely, Government (RIMS, JNIMS, CMC, SAHS-Govt. quota, RDC), Management (SAHS Management) and NRI (SAHS NRI) at the time of registration. Multiple choices are allowed subject to payment of relevant fees. Once final submission is completed, seat type selections are **permanently locked**.
5. **Re-categorization, modifications, or alteration requests** of particulars entered during registration **are strictly prohibited across the current and all future counselling rounds without exception**.
6. Refundable Security Fees will be forfeited if a candidate fails to join the Institute in the Second or subsequent rounds within the stipulated joining time. Refundable Security Fees will also be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled after the second round for any reason.
7. Candidates shall undertake and declare that the information given at the time of registration is correct and complete to the best of his/her knowledge and that he/she may be prosecuted under any court of law for wilfully submitting wrong information or suppressing material facts, if there is any.
8. No candidate shall be allowed to change/alter his/her existing data of NEET UG 2026 as received from the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), DGHS, Government of India, at the time of registration.
9. Information regarding fee structures may be obtained from the colleges concerned before filling in the "Seat Choices".
10. Candidates may lock their "Seat Choices" within the stipulated timeline, after which they cannot be modified. Even if the "Seat Choices" are not locked by the candidate, the choices shall be auto-locked at the end of the stipulated timeline.
11. Any updates on the Schedule / latest updates / Results / Notices / News & Events regarding the online counselling may be obtained from the DHS website www.manipurhealthdirectorat.mn.gov.in or the web-based application <https://manipurmc.mn.gov.in>.



12. The DME reserves its absolute right to alter, amend, modify, or apply any or some of the instructions/guidelines. In case of any ambiguity in the interpretation of any of the instructions/terms/rules/criteria, the interpretation of the DME shall be final and binding in nature.
13. Candidates must ensure that the mobile number and e-mail ID furnished at the time of Registration are their own or those of their parents/guardians only, as DME will communicate only through SMS or e-mail on the given mobile number and e-mail ID. DME shall NOT be responsible for any incorrect credentials. Any complaint with regard to change of registered mobile number or e-mail address shall not be entertained by the DME.
14. Applications once submitted cannot be withdrawn. Mere deduction of fees from the bank account shall not be treated as proof of fee payment. The Acknowledgement Slip of Registration shall be the confirmatory proof of fee payment.
15. Registration in the web-based application will be allowed before every Round of Counselling. Candidates who have registered for any round of counselling need not register again for further rounds. However, "Choice Filling" in the web-based application shall be mandatory for every round of counselling. "Choice of seat" filled in any round shall not be valid for further rounds.
16. Candidates who have not registered in the First Round may make Fresh Registration for the Second Round, subject to payment of the prescribed fees and fulfilment of applicable eligibility conditions.
17. Refund will be processed as per the Counselling Scheme once all the applicable rounds are completed.

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ANNEXURE B: SOP FOR SECOND ROUND OF COUNSELLING

1. All candidates participating in the Second Round, whether previously registered candidates or freshly registered candidates, shall be required to exercise Fresh Seat Choices.
2. The choices filled and locked by a candidate during the First Round shall not be treated as valid for the Second Round.
3. Candidates shall accordingly be required to submit fresh choices of courses/institutions in order of their preference during the Second-Round Choice Filling window, failing which they shall not be included in the merit list for the said round of counselling and hence shall not be considered for allotment in the said round.
4. Candidates shall save and lock their choices within the prescribed timeline.
5. Process of Seat Allotment: Seat allotment shall be done based on Manipur Medical MBBS/BDS/BASLP (Selection of Candidates for Nomination) Rules, 2021 and its Amendment Rules, 2025.
6. Publication of result of Round-2 on the official website www.manipurhealthdirectorates.mn.gov.in and issue of allotment letter to the allotted candidates on the online portal.
7. Allotted Candidates shall download the "allotment letter" from the web-based application <https://manipurmc.mn.gov.in>.
8. Candidates shall be required to choose their preference of either "FREEZE", "FLOAT" or "REJECT" to proceed further
9. Physical Reporting with original documents at the allotted Medical/Dental College against Round-2 for candidates who do not want upgradation (**FREEZE CANDIDATES**).
10. Candidates who want to upgrade their seat in further Rounds can give their willingness for upgradation online. (**FLOAT CANDIDATES**). Such candidates do not need to physically report at the allotted college. They shall download the "Provisional Admission letter" from the web-based application <https://manipurmc.mn.gov.in> after due verification by the respective Institutes. However, candidates allotted seats in the Regional Dental College (RDC), Guwahati shall mandatorily report physically to the Institute for verification of original documents and completion of admission formalities. The provisions relating to Online Verification and Online Provisional Admission shall not apply to such candidates.



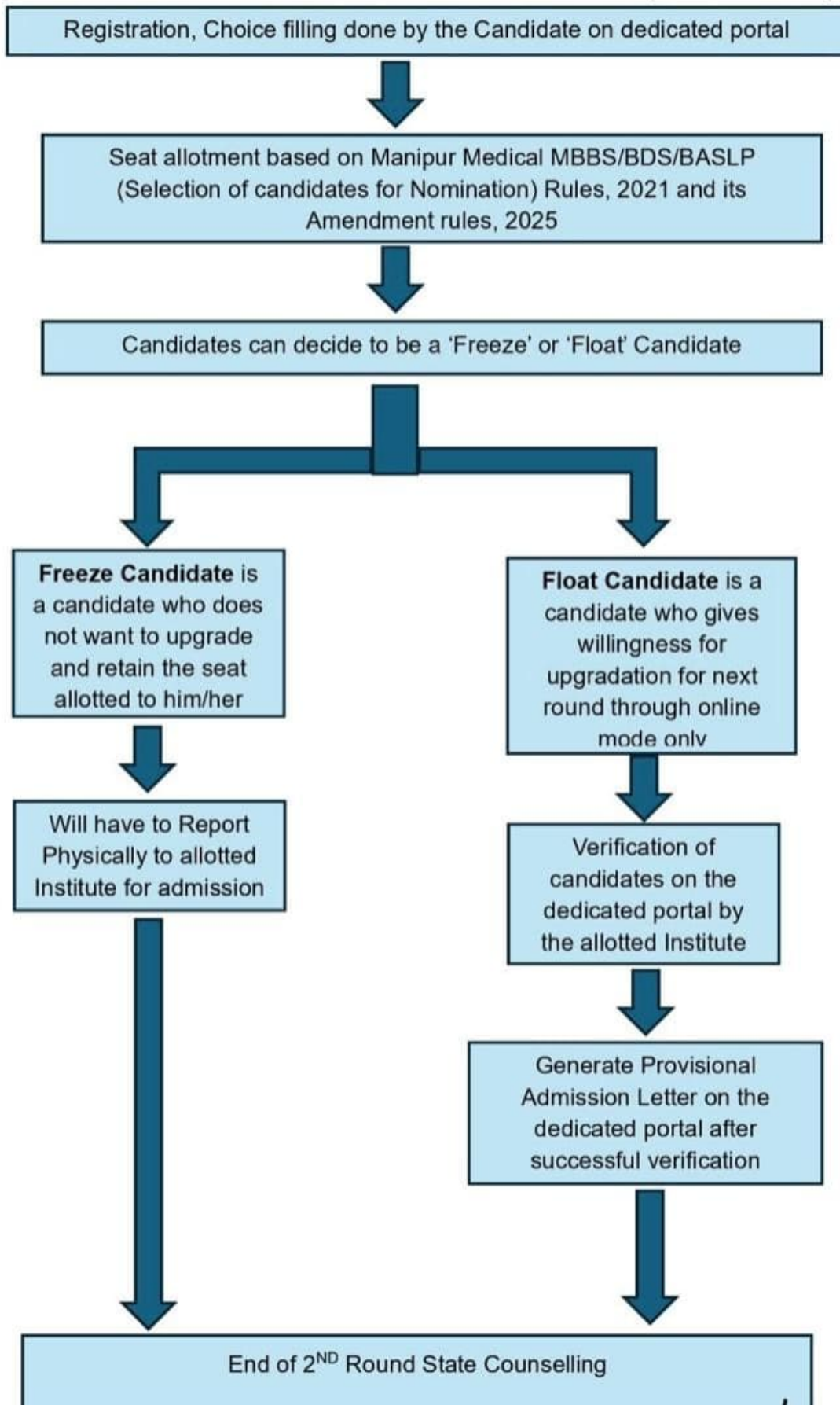
Process for Seat Withdrawal (Resignation)/Surrender Process for Candidates allotted in Second Round of Counselling.

The process of resignation/ seat surrender based on the willingness of the candidate will be as follows for Freeze/ Float Candidates:

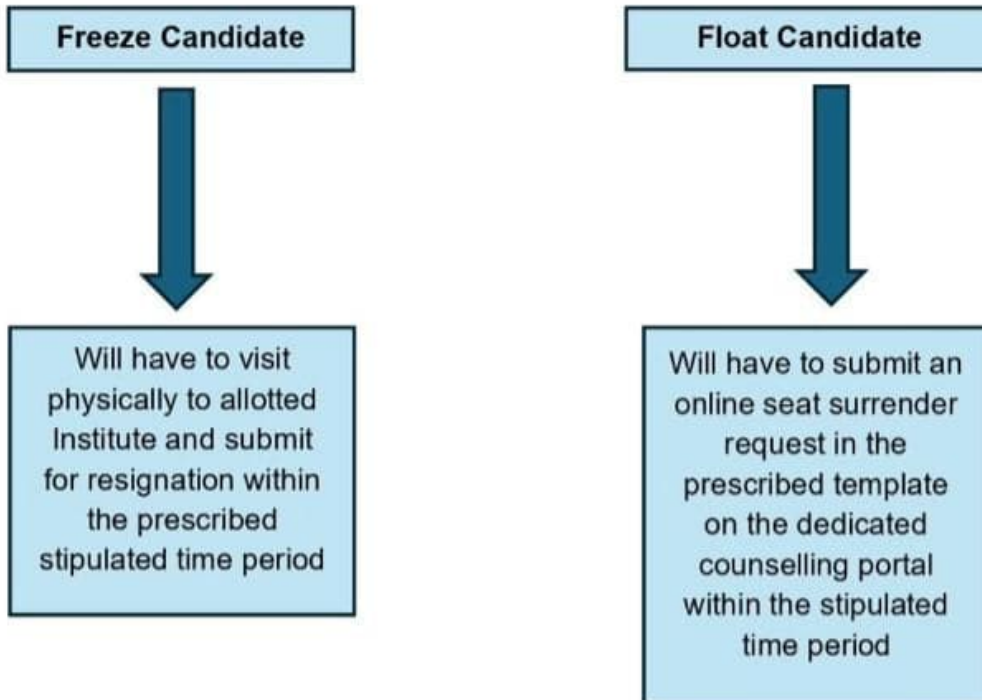
1. FREEZE CANDIDATE- will have to visit the allotted institute physically for resignation
 - a) Candidate will physically report at the allotted institute and submit Resignation within the stipulated time period prescribed by DME to be eligible for next round of counselling.
 - b) Once a seat is surrendered/resigned, candidate will have NO claim on that particular seat.
2. FLOAT CANDIDATE
 - a) Candidates with provisional admission may submit an online seat surrender request in the prescribed template on the counselling portal within the stipulated time period prescribed by DME.
 - b) Once a seat is surrendered/resigned, the candidate will have NO claim on that particular seat and forfeit the security deposit.
